

Investment Overview

City of Talent Solar + Battery Project

The Oregon Clean Power Co-op will install a ground-mounted 75 kW solar + battery system on city property next to Talent's Community Center, at 110 East Main Street in Talent. This project will reduce the City's carbon footprint and electric bills, and will provide emergency power for the Community Center in the event the utility grid goes down. The project will produce enough power to offset most of the electrical use of Talent's City Hall and Town Hall as well. Financing for the project will come from investment by community members, the Energy Trust of Oregon, and a Renewable Energy Development grant from the Oregon Dept. of Energy. There is no tax investor for this project.

Use of Funds

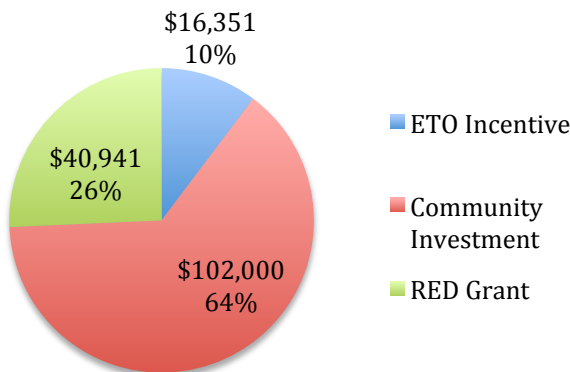
OCPC will use the funds raised to pay for equipment, installation and other project costs. BE Solar will install the system for OCPC, who will sell the power it produces to the City of Talent. The city's savings on electricity will enable it to pay OCPC for the power, and OCPC will use those payments to pay back the investors in the project. After twelve years, the city will take over ownership of the system.
