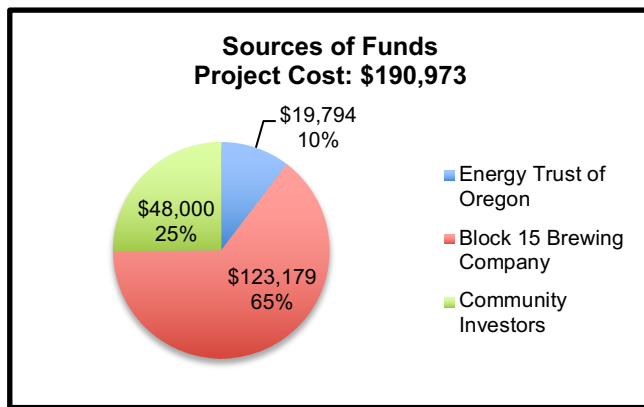


Investment Overview

Block 15 Brewing Company Solar Project

Proudly brewer-owned since its founding in 2008, Block 15 Brewing Company produces a range of artfully crafted beers, brewed with a nod toward fresh ingredients and fresh thinking. The company's unique hop-forward ales, crisp lagers, barrel-aged rarities and one of the Northwest's most extensive wild & sour programs are brewed at its two breweries in Corvallis, and distributed throughout the Pacific Northwest and beyond.

Block 15 is deeply committed to sustainability, and is now partnering with the Oregon Clean Power Cooperative and the Corvallis Sustainability Coalition to install 98 kW of solar panels at the Block 15 Brewery and Tap Room, at 3415 SW Deschutes St., Corvallis, OR 97333. The solar panels are expected to produce more than 124,400 kWh of clean, renewable electricity annually, equivalent to not driving a passenger car 221,500 miles. Most of the financing for the project will come from Block 15 Brewing, which is expected to receive tax benefits equal to the amount of its investment. The remainder of the financing for the project will come from an incentive from Energy Trust of Oregon and from investment from community members, through the Oregon Clean Power Co-op.

The funds raised will be loaned to Block 15 Brewing Company, which will add them to grant funds to pay for installation of the system. Block 15's savings on electricity will enable it to pay back the loan to OCPC, which in turn will pay back the investors in the project.
